Minutes of the Guyton City Council Meeting held on Tuesday, July 26, 2016 at Guyton City Hall at 7:00 pm.

Present: Mayor Jeff Lariscy, Councilmen Steve Collins, Councilmen Franklin Goldwire, Councilmen Michael Johnson, City Attorney Ray Smith, City Clerk Lauree Morris as well as citizens.

Mayor Lariscy called the meeting to order. A moment of repose was held for those who may practice another faith, followed by the invocation by Joseph Lee. The pledge of allegiance was said.

Mayor Lariscy asked for consideration to approve the Amended Agenda, which was made by Councilmen Goldwire, seconded by Councilmen Johnson, and approved.

Mayor Lariscy asked for consideration to approve the minutes from the July 14, 2016 council meeting. Councilmen Johnson so moved; Councilmen Goldwire seconded and the minutes were approved.

Mayor Lariscy asked for consideration to approve the minutes from the July 15, 2016 special called council meeting. Councilmen Goldwire so moved; Councilmen Collins seconded and the minutes were approved.

PLANNING AND ZONING: No report.

No other committee reports were provided.

OLD BUSINESS:

Mayor Lariscy requested a review of the Utility Permit Ordinance regarding right-of-way permits. Due to technical issues at the last council meeting, the revised version of the ordinance created by Attorney Smith was not executed, although it was distributed to everyone. This review will be the second reading and adoption of the correct version. Mayor Lariscy called for a motion to accept the final reading and adopt the ordinance. Councilmen Johnson so moved; Councilmen Goldwire seconded and the ordinance was approved.

Mayor Lariscy called for a second reading and adoption to cancel the second monthly council meeting. Councilmen Johnson so moved; Councilmen Goldwire seconded and the matter was approved.

Mayor Lariscy called for a review of personnel categories, and new policy of Fair Labor Standards Act. Clerk Morris presented a memo and documentation on the matter. After discussion, council acknowledged that there are items that need clarification. Inasmuch, we will compile questions for the attorney and the accountant. In order to provide review time, the matter was tabled until the September 13 meeting.

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Mayor Lariscy called for a review of the City Manager ordinance as to whether or not an amendment is needed based on recent requisition processing revision. Attorney Smith is to review this matter so it was tabled until the August council meeting.

After no additional business, comments or votes, Mayor Lariscy called for a motion to adjourn the meeting. Councilmen Goldwire made the motion, which was seconded by Councilmen Collins and approved. Meeting adjourned.
