## **Minutes of the Millage Rate Public Hearing held on Tuesday, August 15, at Guyton City Hall at 11:00 am.**

Present: Mayor Jeff Lariscy, Councilman Steve Collins, Councilman Michael Johnson, Councilman Franklin Goldwire, City Manager Thomas Wirth, City Clerk Alison Bruton, as well as citizens.

Mayor Lariscy called the meeting to order.

An invocation was led by Robert Hunter. The pledge of allegiance was led by Councilman Johnson.

Mayor Lariscy asked for the approval of the agenda. Councilman Johnson made a motion to accept, seconded by Councilman Collins. Motion carried.

Mayor Lariscy called for the discussion to increase the City of Guyton Millage Rate to 2.72 mills from 2.2 mills, an increase of 26.02%. Mayor Lariscy presented a document containing three (3) graphs representing a comparison between Guyton and surrounding municipalities (attached to minutes). The hearing provided an opportunity for those in attendance to voice concerns and address Council.

After addressing all concerns, there were no more comments. Councilman Johnson made a motion to adjourn the City Council Meeting, seconded by Councilman Collins. Motion carried.
