Minutes of the Guyton City Council Meeting held on Thursday, January 12, 2017, at Guyton City Hall at 2:00 pm.

Present: Mayor Jeff Lariscy, Councilman Steve Collins, Interim City Manager Lauree Morris, Interim City Clerk Alison Bruton, as well as citizens. Councilman Franklin Goldwire and Councilman Michael Johnson called into the meeting.

Mayor Lariscy called the meeting to order.

A moment of repose was held for those who may practice another faith, followed by the invocation by Councilman Collins. The pledge of allegiance was led by Mayor Lariscy.

Mayor Lariscy asked for a motion to approve the agenda. A motion was made by Councilman Goldwire, and was seconded by Councilman Collins. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

Mayor Lariscy called for the acceptance of the updated contract with Hofstader & Associates for the Wastewater Treatment Plant project. It was stated that due to the construction being smaller than the original contract projected, this contract reflected the lesser amount of the cost. Councilman Collins made a motion to accept the contract, and was seconded by Councilman Johnson. During the discussion, Interim City Manager Morris stated that the budget analysis reflecting payments that have already been made on the contract should be included with the revised contract. Councilman Collins amended his motion to agree with the contract adding the addendum to include the budget analysis. Councilman Johnson seconded and the motion passed.

NEW BUSINESS:

Mayor Lariscy called for the acceptance of a proposal for civil engineering services from Parker Engineering for the Wastewater Treatment Plant. It was stated that this would ensure that everything was continuing smoothly with the construction. After some discussion, Councilman Collins made a motion to approve the proposal, seconded by Councilman Johnson. Councilman Goldwire asked if the cost for this proposal would exceed the savings from the new contract with Hofstader, which he was informed would not. After no further discussion, the motion passed.

Mayor Lariscy called for additional comments relating to the Agenda. After none, Councilman Collins moved that we adjourn the council meeting. Councilmen Goldwire seconded, and the motion was approved by all.
