Minutes of the Special Called Guyton City Council Meeting held on Tuesday, June 20, 2017, at Guyton City Hall at 4:30 pm.

Present: Mayor Jeff Lariscy, Councilman Steve Collins, Interim City Manager Lauree Morris, Interim City Clerk Alison Bruton, as well as citizens. Council Goldwire was not in attendance; however, there was a quorum.

Mayor Lariscy called the meeting to order.

An invocation was led by Joseph Lee. The pledge of allegiance was led by Mayor Lariscy.

Mayor Lariscy asked for the approval of the amended agenda. Councilman Johnson made a motion to accept, seconded by Councilman Collins. Motion carried.

OLD BUSINESS:

Mayor Lariscy called for the second reading of the FY 2017.2018 budget. There was discussion regarding the use of the City fund balance monies to balance the budget; however, there is concern because of the purchase of fund accounting software that will take place during said budget year as well. Councilman Collins made a motion to approve the FY 2017.2018 budget as presented with a review at the July 11, 2017 Council Meeting to amend the budget as necessary. Motion was seconded by Councilman Johnson and passed.

Mayor Lariscy called for the second reading of the amendment to the Zoning Ordinance Section 1104(1). Councilman Collins made a motion to approve the amendment, seconded by Councilman Johnson. Motion carried.

NEW BUSINESS:

Mayor Lariscy called for a discussion regarding the allocation of funds for the PD vehicle repairs. Interim Director of Public Safety Strickland advised Council of the work needed on the vehicle at this time. Councilman Collins requested to know where the Police Department stands on all budget items, and Mayor Lariscy stated a review needed to be completed. Councilman Johnson stated that additional bids for the work needed to be gathered. Councilman Collins made a motion to move money as necessary for the work to be completed after the additional bids are collected, seconded by Councilman Johnson. Motion carried.

Councilman Johnson made a motion to adjourn the City Council Meeting, seconded by Councilman Collins. Motion carried.
